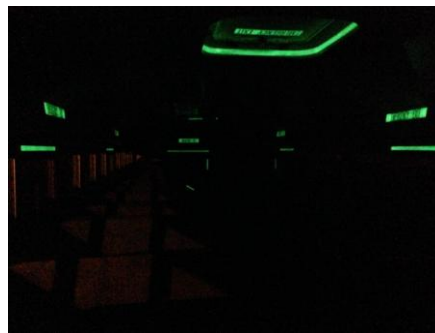

Emergency Exit Hatch



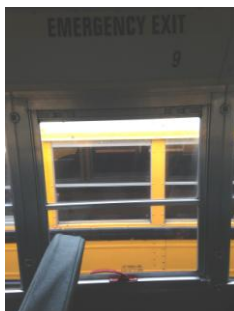

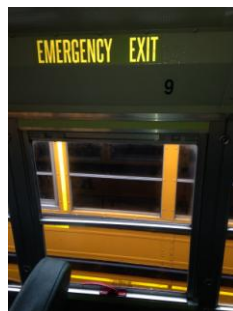
